1. ALL Paystubs for the last 6 months.
2. Any other income from any other sources. (Examples: child support, alimony, pension, unemployment, IRA distributions, rental income, gifts from family/friends)
3. Most recent statements for all secured debt (for property you plan on keeping) Examples: homes, cars, furniture, electronics, IRS etc. OR current amount owed and number of payments left.
4. Monthly out of pocket expenses (“out of pocket” refers to expenses that are NOT deducted from paystubs. Keep in mind these expenses need to have documentation for verification. HOWEVER, our office DOES NOT need the documentation at this time. JUST provide the monthly amounts per the review period.)
 - a. Out of pocket medical expenses (which includes co-pays, prescriptions, over the counter meds, eye exams and eye wear, dental expenses, vitamins and supplements).
 - b. Out of pocket life insurance-
 - c. Out of pocket health insurance-
 - d. Out of pocket disability
 - e. Out of pocket tithes/charitable cash contribution
5. Copy of Lawsuits
6. 2020, 2021 Tax Returns
7. Copies of bank statements (6 months) from all open bank accounts including (**prepaid credit cards? Venmo? Paypal**)
8. Copy of Driver's license and social security card.
9. For all vehicles titled in your name - mileage and VIN#-
10. Complete Budget and Valuation of Household Goods. See website, Resources tab for the link to download the worksheet.
11. Review the credit report, when provided. If any creditors are missing (including collection agencies and medical bills) provide one MOST RECENT statement. We do NOT need multiple statements from each individual creditor. If you do not have copies of the statements, please provide name/address of creditor.
12. Complete pre-filing credit counseling (after you turn in your paperwork because the certificate is only good for 6 months). Once completed have the certificate sent to us by putting in the office code of **knash1** See website, Resources tab for link to get started.
